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The will of Ansel Hall Desd
made some time in June 1841 in his last
Sickness and committed to writing the 5th &
August 1841 calling on Jesse W Chapman and
Joseph P Ellis to take notes that he Desired
that his wife Rachel Hall should have his
horse called Whip and all of the present crop
of corn wheat & oats also all of the hogs he bought
of Moses and George Chapman

attest

Jesse W Chapman
Joseph P Ellis

and the rest of his property
to be equally divided amongst
his children

also County got Sept 8th 1841

This nuncupative will was
proved by the oaths of Jesse W Chapman &
Joseph P Ellis and ordered to be recorded
and thereupon Hardin Haines took the oath
required by law with Thomas Hall and
Henderson Hall executed bond in the penalty
of \$1400 conditioned according to law a
certificate is granted him for obtaining letters
of administration of the Estate of Ansel
Hall dead with the will annexed in due
form att Ch Henderson clk
