It is my will wish and desire that my slaves hereon after named be and go free from servitude as slaves (servit) My negro woman slave Crecy and all her children of the following names, March Sledge Jane Nigil Bibb to the above named negro slaves I hereby direct shall be and remain free and slaves to no persons from and after the day of my death and for the present I do not feel disposed to make by this will any further disposition of the remainder of my Estate of any description and do require and request my Executors or administrators as the case may be to see that the provisions of this will be fully carried out In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hands and seal this 3^d day of August 1842 Elizabeth ^{her} ~~mark~~ ^{mark}

In the name of God Amen I William Phillips of the County of Worcester and State of Connecticut being of sound mind and disposing memory and being admonished by my extreme old age and consequent infirmities that I must ultimately go the way of mortality think it proper and prudent to make such disposition of my worldly effects as my Executive inform me is usage and just and for that purpose I do hereby and lawfully and declare this to be my will and last will and testament -

Which it is my wish and desire that as soon after my death as Circumstances will permit that all my just debt and burial charges be paid I will wish and desire that my executors hereinafter named shall hold all the Land I have or may hereafter be heir unto such terms and Conditions as my Executor may deem most conducive to the interest of my heirs and for that purpose I hereby vest my executors with full and ample authority to sell and Convey by deed my Land as aforesaid and when so shall I will and desire that the proceeds of my Land be equally divided amongst all my Sons and Daughters that is each of my Children are to have an equal portion or share the only but that and provision I now make I will and bequeath to my Daughter Nancy Colver believing that she has not heretofore had quite an equal share with my other Children and lastly I remember and appoint my son Elijah and Mary Phillips
