I Erasmus Bishop of Ohio County & State of Kentucky being in bad health but of sound mind have taken in hand to dispose of all my effects as seemeth good to me which I do hereinafter devise & bequeath
1st I desire all my Just debts paid and when that is done I will and bequeath unto my son Samuel O^r Bishop one hundred acres of land say the land on which I now live which land the above named Samuel O^r Bishop is to have and to hold as his own lawful property at my death and I do will & bequeath unto my son Samuel O^r Bishop three head of horse & creatures now in my possession also 6 head Cattle it being all the Cattle and horses owned by me and in my possession and all my sheep and all my stock of Hogs more or less and all farming utensils with all the house hold & kitchen furniture which property the above named Samuel O^r Bishop is to have & to hold as his own rightfull property for ever in consideration of and for the above bequeath the above named Samuel O^r Bishop is bound to take care of and to sustain both myself Erasmus Bishop his father and Anne Bishop his mother and

wife of Erasmus Bishop during our natural lives which care and support is to be a reasonable and comfortable support and I also will and bequeath unto Samuel O^r Bishop a certain head of cows the price not being included in the above part of this my will and testament and I do will and bequeath unto my daughter Anne M^r Howard one dollar I do will and bequeath unto my son John I Bishop one dollar I do will and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth I do will and bequeath unto my son David one dollar I do will and bequeath unto my son Thompson O^r Bishop one dollar I do will and bequeath unto my son William O^r Bishop one dollar and also I do will and bequeath unto my son Samuel O^r Bishop my executor to this my last will & testament in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 5th day of December in the year of our Lord 1848
