Item 4th I will and bequeath my woman Amey to my wife during her natural life and at the death of my wife she is to live with any of my children that she chooses to stay with

Item 5th I do hereby constitute and appoint my son William Milton and Byron Dickson my sole executors of this my last will and testament and further do renounce all other wills and testaments As witness my hand and seal this 25 September 1844

The last will and testament of Joseph Warden of Ohio County Jy in the name of God Amen I Joseph Warden of the ss County being in but moderate health but of sound mind and disposing memory for which I thank God and being desirous to dispose of all such worldly goods as it has hath pleased God to bless me with I do wish and it is my will that all my perishable property be sold with the exception of such articles as I may dispose of otherwise with my just debts and funeral expenses paid out of the proceeds and I will and bequeath to my wife Sarah one third of all my real estate during her life and at her death my son I also will and bequeath to my wife Sarah the following species of personal property viz my Cupboard and furniture bureau press four beds and their furniture all my kitchen furniture Table Clock which she is to have and enjoy during her natural life and at her death to be sold and the proceeds to be divided equally between Susan Warden Jesse Warden Nancy Glehart Elizabeth Dexter and Coleman Calvert so it is my will that my administrator when

he collects in the money and the money that is coming to me otherwise to pay five dollars to each of my children viz Ivan Warden and Jesse Warden Nancy Igleheart Elizabeth deader now warden Garner Wade Elmer Calvert the balance to remain in the hands of the administrator for the benefit of my wife Sarah left 22nd 1844

Just debts be paid with as little delay as practicable but to use all legal means to resist claims that in his Judgement may appear unjust hereby authorizing him and Empowering him to sell and otherwise dispose of all my property of ^{any} kind real or personal as in his Judgement may seem most Conducing to the interests herein after named after the payments of my said debts I will and bequeath all the rest and residue of my Estate of which I am possessed to my friend and relative Joseph Barnett the Executor hereto with the Condition that if there should be property of much value after the payments of debts and after paying for the "double" expence I have Course said Joseph and family I request that my said Executor give over such part as he may chare to do or give to my relative Abby Baird ^{or} twice but this I leave Entirely to his discretion and Judgement and for him to do as he pleases hereby declaring him my only and residuary Legatee In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 5th day of August 1844
