

In the Name of god Amen David Tanner of the County of Ohio and State of Kentucky being Sick in Person but of a sound mind and disposing memory thanks be to god for the same calling to mind the uncertainty of human life Knowing that ~~he~~ is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will and testament that is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul in to the hands of Almighty god that gave it and my Body I recommend to the Earth from whence it came to be buried in a christian like manner at the of my Executrix and as touching such worldly Estate where with it has pleased god to Bless me with in this life I give and bequeath in the following manner that is to say I give and bequeath unto my wife Rachael Tanner in case that she should be the longest lived all of my Real and personal Estate during her natural life time so long as she remains a widow to ~~also~~ as she pleases with and if my said wife should marry after my death then my will and request is that the real and personal Estate all be sold and Equally divided between my eight children to wit Jonathan Tanner Henry Tanner Sally Tanner Anne Sally Henderson Polly Tanner William Tanner Elizabeth Tanner Jane Tanner and Luina Tanner after all the rest gets as much as Jonathan Tanner and Sally Henderson has had and Jonathan Tanner has had \$36.00 and Sally Henderson has had \$27.50 etc

and my will is that if my wife Rachael Tanner should have any thing to spare more than a sufficiency for the use of the family that she give my son Henry as much as Jonathan Tanner has had my will and request is that my wife Rachael Tanner be my Executrix and at her marriage or death that all my Real and personal Estate be sold on a credit of 12 months and that there be no appraisers appointed that there be no appraisement nor no expenses only the Recording of this will in witness whereunto I set my hand and set my Seal this 31st day of October 1841

In the name of god Amen I Loyd Barnard of Ohio County Kentucky being of sound mind and disposing memory do hereby make and publish this my last will and Testament hereby Hereto and declaring null and void all others heretofore by me made First it is my will and desire that all

my Just debts be paid as soon after my
 decease as practicable it is my will and
 desire and I so declare that my Negro boy
 John be and remain a Slave to my heirs untill
 he arrives at the age of thirty one years old
 and then at that age to become fully -
 emancipated and go free for ever
 it is my will wish and desire that my
 beloved wife Nancy be appointed and I hereby
 appoint her my Executrix to Carry into
 effect the provisions of this will namely
 it is my will and desire that said
 Executrix dispose of so much only of my
 personal property as she may deem conducive
 to the interest of my heirs and that she
 have the entire use and Control of all my
 said Estate for the purpose of raising and
 Educating our children during her natural
 life or widowhood and in the event of
 her subsequent marriage I direct that then
 and in that case that she shall only retain
 one third part of my said Estate and
 that the residue of my Estate be Equally
 divided except as to my oldest son Richard
 I give him as his own property a Bay
 Suckling Colt this I give him to be in no
 wise Subject to the disposition of my said
 Executrix and over and above a fair Equal
 Share and proportion of my Estate amongst
 my children and I direct that as soon as
 children and each of them shall become
 of Lawfull age that each of them be entitled
 to their respective Share of my personal
 Estate It is my will and desire that my
 Executrix keep out at interest in safe
 hands all the money that can be spared

or is not absolutely necessary for the Reasonable
 Support of my children and it is my desire
 that my Executrix before named be Committed
 and advised in all her actings in the
 premises by discreet well informed persons so
 as to enable her to act and do for the benefit
 of my heirs In witness whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand and Seal this 1st day of September
 1841
