I further more authorized her my said attorney to Sell adjust receive and receipt for any money property in any kind or manner and she is to be deemed to be my receipt from all persons whatsoever and their receipts and acquittances to good for the same by using and signing my name in as full and proper a manner as if I could do myself and I do hereby publish and declare all and every act or acts of my said agent and attorney in the premises as obligatory and binding on me as if all her aforesaid acts were done and performed by myself and in person proper person hereby attesting and confirming all her said acts in the premises and I do hereby further declare that the said Mary Ann is in the secret of not having or receiving me in to have all the property or money that I may die possessed of by the said land personal or other estate for her to have forever for her own personal use and benefit subject to her own disposition having the right of Creditors and I hereby
