I Thomas Briant of the County of Ohio and State of Kentucky, being weak in body but of sound and disposing memory and calling to mind the shortness of life and certainty of death do hereby make my last will and testament

- 1st I give to my son Samuel one dollar
 - 2nd I give to my daughter Sally Newcome one dollar
 - 3rd I give to my son Asa also the same of one dollar
 - 4th I give to my son Haratis T Briant the sum of one dollar
 - 5th I give to my son Eli the sum of one dollar
 - 6th and lastly I give to my son William my plantation and all of my property both real and personal including my waggon and gear
- In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand caused my seal to be Affixed
