I desire that my son Sion & Marlow shall have my yellow girl Kettie for his portion of my estate but in case she should die before me I wish him to be equal share with the balance of my children. I desire that the farm on which I now live with all the remainder of my property to be sold and my black mare David at the end of the year that he work for my daughter Eliza Huff and that the proceeds thereof be equally divided between the balance of my children viz Nancy Marlow's children & my son John W. Marlow's children My daughter Mary E. Chumley and my son Mary E. Chumley Thomas Marlow and my daughter Elizabeth Smith and my daughter Mahalia Silmores and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my son Sion & Marlow executor of this my last will and testament.
