It is my will wish and desire that my slaves hereinafter named be and go free from servitude as slaves (servile). My negro woman slave Cressy and all her children of the following names, Maria Siddy Jane Vigil Biddy the above named negro slaves I hereby direct shall be and remain free and slaves to no persons from and after the day of my death and for the present I do not feel disposed to make by this will any further disposition of the remainder of my Estate of any description and do require and request my Executors or administrators as the case may be to see that the provisions of this will be fully carried out. I also wish and desire that my executor hereinafter named shall sell all the land I have or may hereafter be due upon such terms and conditions as my Executor may deem most for the interest of my heirs and for that purpose I hereby trust my executor with full and ample authority to sell and convey by deed and make as otherwise and when he shall see fit and I will and desire that the proceeds of my land be equally divided amongst all my sons and daughters that is each of my Children are to have an equal portion of share the my but that and provisions I now and I will and bequeath to my Daughter Nancy Cohen believing that she has not heretofore had quite an equal share with my other Children and lastly I nominate and appoint my son Elijah and Nancy Phillips

Dear wife I am well and just about starting on board of the Steam boat Paul Bay, and on next Thursday I expect to land in New Orleans I have nothing, particularly to write to you but I will write immediately from New Orleans and I expect to get home by the 2^d week in May and perhaps some it expected to get you something from this place but I cannot find any good cation here but if I should come across any before I start off I will send you a drop for fear I may not live to receive home and if I never should I want this letter to show that it is my wish I will that you shall have every thing that I wish in this world and that for your safety it is my wish that your father would administer on my estate and save all that he can for you my dear wife this I will agree
