Third I have paid on the place on which I live the sum of 200⁰⁰ there being a balance of 400⁰⁰ due on same which is secured by notes of 700⁰⁰ encumbrance which I want my wife Anna Eliza as above named to pay either by sale or otherwise so as to secure a home - Should she have to sell the above named real estate to pay the purchase money she may elect her choice either to sell privately or publicly she freely after paying notes if there be any ever again purchasing another home for my children and wife as above stated

Fourth Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my wife Anna Eliza Jane Johnson to be Executor of my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made which shall be executed solely by my wife above named without bond - no bond is needed
