of my wife all is to be divided equally among my children

my sole executor and Renounce all other wills & executors
and this to be my last will & Testament in Witness hereof I set
my hand & seal this twenty eighth day June in Year of our
Lord god one thousand eight hundred and one Signed
Sealed and pronounced to be my last will & Testament in
