and infirm but of sound mind and memory do make
Ordain and publish this my last Will and Testament
After my Decease I ~~do~~ desire that my body may be
Consigned to the Earth by a Christian burial and
my Spirit I commend to God who gave it

As to the worldly Goods it hath pleased the almighty
to Bless me with I wish to be Disposed of in the
following manner (to wit) all my Just debts and
funeral expences to be first paid My bed and the
Bed cloaths and my Chest with Drawers and all
my Books and every other article I had with me
to the house of Mr. Masterson Ogden where I now
Reside I give and Bequeath to Mrs. Rebecca Ogden and
her heirs for ever Likewise a Cow and six Sheep I
give and Bequeath to Mrs. Rebecca Ogden and her
heirs for ever my Negro woman slave Ponce I hereby
Emancipate and for ever set free I hereby authorize
and Direct my Executor here in after named or such
others as shall Administer and Carry in to effect
this my last Will and Testament that they Retain
in their hands the balance of my estate (About two
hundred Dollars) that aforesaid disposed of here in
for the support of my said Negro woman Ponce and
I desire that Mr. Masterson Ogden shall act
the part of guardian to Ponce and I do hereby direct
him to take all my expences for her support of the
aforesaid charge I will that after my Executors have
been paid for their travels and expences which may be
Considerable that the Balance of my estate if there be
any shall belong to and be the property of Masterson
Ogden and his heirs for ever Lastly I do hereby Ordain
and appoint James White living and for Run
and George Beaman living and my wife Executors of
this my last Will and Testament In testimony
I subscribe and publish the foregoing as my last
