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State of Kentucky Shelby County May 1st 1846

I Peter Vandoyke last of the above named state and County being in my right mind but low in health acknowledge this to be my last will & Testament - And in first my will is that after my decease my body be decently buried and I pray Almighty God to Except my soul

Again my will is that my three sons William Richard and Henry be my executors to execute this my will and Testament, but any two of them to serve as they may agree among themselves and my wish is that my executors should consult with Mr. Philip W Taylor in any part of the business of my estate in which they may want directions and my will is that my executors pay my last debts after paying my funeral expenses and further my will is that my present dwelling with two hundred acres of land adjoining together with all the house hold and kitchen furniture remain with my beloved wife Elizabeth Vandoyke her life time and at her decease my will is that the said property be equally divided among all my children according to their proportion of my estate and the remaining part of my lands my will is that my son William & Richard have the two hundred acres of land Called McDonalds place for which land I gave two hundred and eighty pounds which sum I mean the two boys to pay the same sum for in their part of my estate and that they William and Rich and every and proper all the appurtenances belonging to said two hundred acres of land and further my will is that my son Henry have the place Called Joseph Stults place containing one hundred acres with all the appurtenances belonging to said tract of one hundred acres with all the appurtenances belonging to said tract of ~~land~~ one hundred acres and that said Henry pay five dollars per acre for said land in his part of my estate - and further my will is that my son Abraham have the land containing one hundred and five acres that I purchased of Abert Combs and that he pay in his part of my estate four dollars per acres for said land and further my will is that my two sons in law William Stout and Matthias Corbin have the land I purchased of Absalom Carr containing one hundred and sixteen acres and that they divide the same by the present County road that is that said William Stout have that part of said tract which lies on the same side of the road on which said Stout lives and that Corbin have the remaining parts of said one hundred and sixteen acres that lie on the other side of the road and that they pay the price of five dollars per acre in their part of my estate for said land and further my will is that the one hundred acres of land which I purchased of James Gilbert that my incertain sett that piece of land at what Circuit they may judge best for the general benefit of my heirs and further my will is that my negro property should be valued by Philip W Taylor and William Margins and that my beloved wife Elizabeth Vandoyke have her lawful thirds of said negro property

her life time, the remaining two thirds my will is that my he
 draw for them by Ballot, except my negro woman Liable
 which is to go free one Year after my decease But should
 said Liable live in these parts so long as she is able and informed I
 not able to help herself my wish is that my executors retain
 a part of my estate in their hands for her support and my
 will is that my daughter Mary have my negro boy Left
 at his valuation in her part of my estate and further my will
 is that my executors, sell all my live stock and plantation utensils
 at twelve months Credit, and all the Crop on hand, of every dis
 position except a sufficiency for the support of the family &
 stock that may remain on the farm and further my will is that
 each of my Children have the sum of two hundred pounds
 from an accurate valuation of my estate and after such
 deduction should there be any ballance that each one shall
 have ⁱⁿ proportion of the remaining ballance but it is to
 be observed that what I have already given any one of
 my Children is to make a part of said two hundred
 pounds for example my son Peter has had £218. 18
