In The Name of God Amen I Rowleigh Bryant being sick of body but of sound mind & memory at present thanks to Almighty God for the same knowing that it is our appointed for all men to die do make this My last will & Testament in Manner & form as follows (viz)

First & principally & Above all I do give My Soul to God that gave it to me & My body to be buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my Exor. hereafter to be mentioned as for my worldly Goods which it had pleased God to Bless me with I do Dispose of as followeth. Item It is my wish that my Negro woman Esther my Negro Girl Rily Mary & Swanna & Their Increase be Equally Divided between My Children to-wit Edigah R. John W. Malinda L. Sophia R. Rowlight W. & Samuel Bryant together with the Rest of My Estate property Consisting of horses house hold Furniture money & the money I have owing to me in Richmond County in Virginia in the hands of my Brother John Bryant it is my wish that my Youngest Children be sent to School as much as possible I do appoint my Brother Samuel Bryant living in Shelby County State of Kentucky Executor to this my last will & Testament as witness my hand and Seal this Seventh day of December 1844

The Commonwealth of Kentucky To Walter Jones Presiding Justice Northumberland County State of Virginia Greeting Whereas the within last will & Testament purporting to be the last will & Testament of Rowleigh Bryant deceased hath been offered for proof to our County Court for Shelby County in the Commonwealth aforesaid and John Linstead & Peter Moore two of the Witnesses Attesting the same besides one of this Commonwealth &c &c Therefore that we trusting to Your fidelity & Provident Circumspection

in diligently examining the said John Grinstead and Peter Moore
 require you in pursuance of the Order of our said County Court that
 on such day & at such place as you shall appoint, you cause the said
 John Grinstead & Peter Moore to come before you & their attestation
 on the holy Evangelist of Almighty God do take and their attestation
 do taken to our County Court off distinctly and plainly without
 delay do you send Certified in the manner such acts are usually
 authenticated by you Returning also the said writing and the writ
 Witness James Craig Clerk of our said Court the 19th day of May 1815
 and in the 23rd Year of the Commonwealth

 contain & express his last Will & Testament and that the said Rowlesigh
 Bryant at the time of their publishing declaring & signing the said
 paper containing his last Will & Testament was of sound and
