 Samuel Shannon deceased, Witnesseth, that whereas the Slaves belonging to
 to the Estate of the Said Decedent and Subject to distribution are insufficient
 in number to bear a division amongst the whole of said heirs and they being
 unwilling that they should be sold in manner as the law in such case hath
 provided do mutually agree in their own right and as Guardians and
 that the said Slaves belonging to said Estate between of the Widows lower
 be divided between William Shannon Saml Shannon Elizabeth
 Shannon Martha Shannon and Mary Shannon and that the
 Other heirs have the right to receive of the Administrators of said Estate
 Money for their proportions of said Slaves agreeable to the Valuation
 thereof by the Commissioners Appointed for the division of them
 In Testimony whereof they have hereunto set their hands and

 to the Estate of my deceased Husband Samuel Shannon

I am willing to receive a negro man & and a negro woman many in full for my
 dower in said Slaves and do hereby relinquish all other right whoso I may have in said Slaves
 to the heirs of said Estate Witness my hand the 20th day of Jan 1817

and

In Obedience to an order of Court the County Court for Shelby County to us directed we have proceeded to allot and assign to Martha Shannon widow of Samuel Shannon deceased her dower in the Slaves belonging to the Estate of said Decedent as follows to wit We valued the whole of the Slaves ^{to} \$2913 out of which we allotted to the said Widow one woman named Mary about 38 or 40 years old at the price of \$275 and one Negro man named Jo at the price of \$1410 which lacked \$256 dollars of the amount of the one third of the value of the whole of the Slaves but the said Widow by her writing agrees to receive the two Negroes Mary and Jo in full for her dower in said Slaves which writing is herewith filed marked ~~A~~ and made a part of the report the balance of said Slaves were insufficient in number to divide amongst the whole of the heirs of said Decedent and the said heirs being willing that the said Slaves should be sold as the law in such case has provided those that were of lawful age and the guardians of those that are minority entered into a written agreement under their hands and seals which is herewith returned marked B and made part of the report in which they mutually agree that that the whole of said Slaves shall be divided between William Samuel Elizabeth, Martha and Polly Shannon, we therefore have divided them accordingly, To the said William a Man named Jack about 50 years old at the price of \$346 to Samuel one So named Bill at the price of \$600 to Elizabeth one Boy named Jacob about 12 years old at the price of \$350 to Martha one Boy named Charles 7 years old at the price of \$250 and one Girl named Nelly about 10 years old at the price of \$250 and to Mary one Boy named Dick about 14 years old at the price of \$400 All which is respectively Reported &c Witness our hands this 20th Day of January 1817
