I Give that all of my estate be my Son David Proctor
furniture and all that belongs to the Estate be equally Divided
between my three children Greenville Proctor David Proctor and
William Proctor with the exception of their small legacies above
mentioned at the same time I appoint my Son Greenville Proctor
and my wife Elizabeth Proctor my Executors of this my last will
