In the name of God Amen I Daniel Lee of the County of Shelby and State of Kentucky being of Disposition, mind and memory do make and publish this as my last will and Testament, My soul I commend to God who gave it my body to be buried in a Christian like manner my funeral expenses to be first paid also all just Debts for which I am and may hereafter become bound.

The property I may possess of at my decease I wish to be disposed of in the following manner I give Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Rebecca Sharp one dollar to her & her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath Lucretia Ellis my second Daughter one Dollar to her and her heirs forever,

Item. I give & bequeath to my eldest son Nelson Lee one dollar to him and his heirs forever.

Item. I give and bequeath to my son Zachariah Lee one hundred and twenty five acres commonly called his land also fifty acres of Land part of the tract of mine on to be laid off on the north west corner or as not with the improvement of present made on said tract to him & his heirs forever.

Item. I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Lee to her and her heirs forever all and every part remaining of my estate both real and personal to be entirely at her disposal and to be distributed by her at pleasure in point of time amongst the children

born of her own body during her being my wife
and her former two children in the following manner
To wit The children she bears me shall each
have double the amount of each of the children she
has borne her former husband. And should
my said wife Mary out live me and again marry
she shall have and hold as her own such part of my
estate and in such manner as is prescribed by law in
cases where no last will and testament is made lastly
I nominate and appoint my said wife and Mary Lee
and William Ellis Executors of this my last will
and testament

and memory do make this my last will and Testament in
manner and form following to wit:

First of all I give and bequeath to my wife Catharine
Roberts the plantation and land whereon I live together
with all my house hold furniture farming utensils Horses
Cattle Hogs and sheep and a negro man named Jacob during
her natural life and after her death to be equally divided
between my two sons John Roberts and Henry Roberts
to gether with all Debts which may be now owing
to me to be also collected by my aforesaid two sons and
equally Divided between them when collected
and I hereby do appoint my above mentioned two
sons John Roberts and Henry Roberts to my lawful Executors
