Last will & Testament of David McBlain of the County of Shelby and State of
Kentucky being very weak and sick But of perfect sense
and memory Do make Constitute and appoint this my last
will and Testament in the manner and form following

Item I give my soul to god Almighty God my Body to be
Buried at the discretion of my Executors here after mentioned
Item, I give to my son John Ten Shillings to him and his heirs
forever.

Item, I give to my son Thomas & heirs Ten Shilling to them
and their heirs forever.

Item, I give to my Daughter Agnes six Shilling to her & her
heirs forever.

Item, I give to my Daughter Mary six Shilling to her and
her heirs forever.

Item, I give to my son James his heirs six Shillings to them & their heirs
forever.

Item I give to my son ^{Alexander} all that Remains of my Real & personal estate
to him & his heirs forever.

Lastly I do Constitute my friends William Collins and John
Baldwell Executors of this my last will and Testament as witness
my hand and seal this 2nd day of July 1803.
