in hopes of a joyfull Resurrection thro the merit of my Saviour
 Jesus Christ and as for that worldly estate wherewith it has pleased
 God to bless me I dispose thereof as follows that is to say after all
 my just Debts and funeral expences are paid I give to my lie loved
 wife Rachael Pollard a negro Man named Jim during her
 life and at her death to be sold and his price to be Equally
 divided among my children or their heirs. I also give to my
 wife aforesaid One house and Saddle & bow and the kitchen furniture
 I give to my son Elijah Pollard the tracts of land & plantation where
 I now live I also give to my wife One Bed and furniture
 I give to Rachael Finley One Bed & furniture and after the death
 of my wife I wish Rachael Finley to have her house and saddle
 and One bow I also give Rachael Finley One chest and to my wife I wish
 The Ballance of my property I wish and direct to be sold and the
 money to be equally divided among my children in the base of Jim
 and my personal estate I give to the children of Rebecca
 Pollard and to my wife Rachael Pollard is to enjoy
 the possession of the plantation during her life. I do constitute
 and appoint my wife Rachael Pollard my son Elijah Pollard
 and Thomas Mitchell to execute this my last will & Testament
 In witness whereof I have here unto set my hand and seal
 this eighth day of August 1811
