 Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved son James
 Wood One Dollar and no more as I have heretofore given
 him land Money and other property to the full amount
 of what I am able to give him without Ingering my
 other children Therefore I shall give him no more, But
 Only Relinquish all my Right and Title to any property
 and money that I have heretofore given him ^{John and his heirs}
 forever Item 2nd I give and bequeath unto my beloved
 son William Wood One negro girl named Hanniell
 and one dollar and no more to him and his heirs forever
 the said negro he has now in his possession . . . I having given
 him land and other property heretofore is my reason for not

And I hereby Relinquish all My Right and Title to
any Land or other property that he got from me To him
and his heirs forever,

Item 3rd I give and bequeath unto My Beloved Daughter
Elizabeth Kuttelab wife of James Kuttelab one negro
boy about 17 years old named Lewis Also one negro woman
named Rose which negro she has in her possession and for which
I executed a Bill of sale Bearing date the 24 day of March 1809
And Both of the aforesaid Negroes with their increase
and all other property which I give My Daughter heretofore
I now confirm to her and her children forever,

Item 4th Whereas I Executed a Bill of sale to My beloved
Daughter Sarah Wood Dated March 24th 1809 for one
negro woman named Frank and one negro Boy named
Tolliver one Boy More 4 years old one Feather Bed
and furniture and one bow and biff. All of the aforesaid
property which is contained in the aforesaid Bill of sale
with their Increase At the property I have given heretofore
I now confirm give and bequeath unto My said Daughter
Sarah Wood To be her own property from the date
of the said Bill of sale and her children if any she
should have. Forever,

Item 5th Whereas I Executed a Bill of sale to My
beloved Daughter Cytha Coleman wife of Richard
Coleman Dated March the 24th 1809 for one negro
woman

Woman named Jenny and one negro girl named Nancy
and one negro girl named Sophy and Bary more about 3 years
old and yearling colts one feather Bed and furniture and
one horse and belf All of the aforesaid property which is
contained in the said Bill of sale with their Increase And all
other property which I have given her heretofore I now confirm
give and bequeath unto my said Daughter Sytha Coleman
to her her own property from the date of the aforesaid Bill of sale
And her children if she should have forever.

Item 6th Wherein I Executed a Bill of sale of said to my
beloved Daughter ~~John~~ ^{Nancy} Herndon wife of John Herndon
Dated March 24th 1809 for a negro woman named Patsie
which Bill of sale I now confirm and I give and bequeath said
negro and her increase to my said Daughter Nancy Herndon
and her children forever I also give and bequeath unto my
said daughter Nancy a negro Boy named Billy about
Ten years old and sixty Dollars in Money and all other
property that I have given her heretofore To her and her
children forever.

Item 7th Wherein I Executed a Bill of sale to my Beloved
Daughter Fidia Herndon wife of John Herndon Dated
March 24th 1809 for a negro girl named Hero which
Bill of sale I now confirm and I give and bequeath the
said negro and her increase to my said Daughter Fidia
and her children forever I also give and bequeath
unto my said Daughter Fidia Herndon a negro Boy
named Ben Also a negro woman named Femiimah and all other
property that I have given her heretofore to her and her
children forever

378 Item 8th At last of all it is my will and Desire that all the
Remain of my property which I have not before disposed of
whether Real or personal or whatever it may consist of or when
found may be sold at publick sale by my Executors hereafter
named And after all my just & ^{fit} funeral Expenses
and Sixty Dollars above mentioned To Nancy Herndon are all
paid The Remainder to be equally Divided Between my
five Daughters To wit Elizabeth Fettered Sarah Wood Sytha
Coleman Nancy Herndon and Lydia Herndon which
Money I give and bequeath unto them and their children
forever.
