 Will and Testament. Revoking all others Verbal or Written
 by me heretofore made. I gave my soul to god that gave it me
 and ^{my} body to be decently buried and as to my worldly estate I
 gave and bequeath as followeth

Imprimis. I give and bequeath unto my Sister Clerks Children which
 are now born or may hereafter be born one Thousand Acres of land
 to be laid off to them out of the tract of land on Fingers Creek
 to be equally divided between them to them and their heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my Sister Betsey Moriwether
 two sons In: Martin Moriwether and Reuben Moriwether

One Thousand Acres of land out of my tract on Fingers Creek to be
 chosen by their father out of any part of the said tract to them
 and theirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my brother Thomas Daniel one
 Thousand Acres of land in the County of Nelson on the waters
 of Ashes Creek. likewise five Thousand of land out of my Tract
 on Fingers Creek to be chosen by him after the lands I have herein
 before given to my two Sisters Children are first laid off which shall
 be done by my Executors.

Item I give and bequeath to my sister Sukey Morris One Tract
 of land on Floyd Fork and Bulls Skin to her and heirs forever
 which Tract contains Eight Thousand Acres

Item I give and bequeath unto my brother Colman Daniel all
 the Entries and Claims to land Entered in my own Name

and all that I claim by purchase in my own Name but none of those which I claim as heir at law to Walker Daniel to him and his heirs forever

It is my will and Desire that if any of the legates should bring Suit in Order to establish a will made by my brother Walker Daniel many Years before his death that in that Case all those Concerned in the ^{sa} Suit shall have none of the legacies herein given to them but their legacies in that Case shall descend to the other legates to be equally divided amongst them it likewise my will and desire that all debts due to me by bond or otherwise be collected by my Executors and the money arising to be by them appropriated towards the payment of my Just Debts. It is further

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 my will and Desire that all my land and and all other Estate whatsoever be sold by my Executors on such credit and for such Produce Cash or other property as they shall think proper and the money or property arising from such sales to be applied towards the payment of my Just debts and should there be any Ballance remaining in the hands of my Executors from the sale of my Estate after paying all my Just debts it is my will and desire that it be equally divided amongst the legates to this my last will

Item Having omitted to mention before. I give and bequeath unto my father John Daniel five hundred Acres of land to be by my Executors laid off to him out of any of my lands they may think proper to him and his heirs forever I likewise give to him all my wearing Apparel I do authorize and request my Executors

to make deeds to all such lands as I have sold as soon
 as they are required thereunto And whereas I have by agree-
 ment given to my brother Martin Daniel One fourth of all
 my lands before the making of this my will it is my will
 and desire that he shall have the same I do Constitute
 my Brother ^{Martin} Daniel and my Friend Nicholas Mowbrath
 Executors to this my last will In witness hereof I have
 hereunto set my hand & seal this 8th day of August
 in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred &
 Ninety Two.
