In the Name of God Amen I Roger Triplett of the county of Shelby and state Kentucky being weak in body but in full possession of my mind and understanding knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die have thought proper to arrange my worldly concerns and make this my last will & testament.

Item 1st I resign my body to the dust & my soul to God he gave it Item 2nd I do empower

and direct my Executors to collect all my just claims and pay all my just debts with the expence of my funeral & interment out of my estate and the remainder if any thereof to distribute in the manner herein directed. Item 3rd I do bequeath unto my loving sister

Molly Triplett Three hundred acres of land lying in Martin county on the south side of Green river to be taken out of a tract of four hundred and twenty five acres patented in the name of Anna Eliza McCraw.

Item 4th I bequeath unto my chosen George Triplett all the remaining part of the above four hundred and twenty five acres of land

The said lands to be divided as near as may be as to
 quality. Item 5th I bequeath unto my friend Joseph
 Roberts my stud horse and also direct him to sell
 my gray horse to satisfy my just debts and defray
 any other expences that may accrue on my behalf
 Item 6th I do by these presents constitute and appoint
 my true and faithfull friend Joseph Roberts my Legal
 Executor to carry into effect this my last will and testament
 and do all and every other things ^{and} things necessary
 in the premises. In testimony whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand and seal this thirtieth day of december
 in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred
 and five
