and knowing that it is appointed for all men Once to die Do Ordain
this my last will and Testament that is to say Principally and
first of all I Recommend my soul to the hand of God who gave it
and my Body to the earth to be Buried at the discretion of my Executors
nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall Receive the
same again by the power of God and as touching such worldly
estate where with it has Pleased God to bless me in this life I give
and dispose of the same in the following manner first I give and
bequeath to Sarah my Dearly Beloved wife all the stock on my
plantation and all my household goods Excepting to give I give
Barrel and smith tools the land plantation and mill I also appoint
for the support of her and stock while she lives Likewise
Constitute and Ordain my son Eben Miles and Samuel Miles
to be my Sole Executors of this my last will and Testament to
Defray all lawfull expences and collect all lawfull Debts and
see to the Repairing the mill when Out of Order for the support of my
Son Benjamin Miles which is impotent this to be my last will
and Testament disannulling all others in witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand and seal this 11th day of March In the
year One thousand Eight hundred and ~~Eighteen~~ Eleven
