of sound memory thanks be given unto God and knowing
that it is Appointed for all men Once to die do make &
ordain this my last Will and Testament that is to say first
of all I give and recommend my Soul into the hands of
God that gave it and my body to be buried in decent burial
an burial at the hands of my Executors and first of all I
give and bequeath to my well beloved Margat Wilson the
sum of twenty pounds with all her house furniture to be
levied out of my Estate and to remain here till Death and
after her Death that with all the Remainder of my Estate
I give and bequeath to my well beloved Brother Hugh W
on and so remain forever Signed Sealed his
