In the name of God amen I Thomas Threlkeld of the county of Mercer & state of Virginia do order this my last will and testament as follows, Item, it is my desire that my loving wife Nelly Threlkeld have & enjoy my two negro men namely James & Robin during her natural life, and after her death it is my desire that the two negroes namely James & Robin be equally divided by appraisement

between George & Daniel Threlkeld sons of my brother John

Threlkeld also Thomas & M^{rs} Threlkeld sons of M^{rs} Threlkeld share & share alike between them four & their heirs forever except hereafter mentioned also it is my desire that the said Nelly Threlkeld have & enjoy all my personal estate and at her death to be equally divided between Daniel Threlkeld McConky and Amstead Long that is to say my household furniture & stock also leave to the said Daniel Threlkeld

McConky one negro boy named Joseph to be put to the joiners trade with the said Daniel and at that expiration of the said Daniels apprenticeship then the said Daniel Threlkeld McConky take possession of said negro Joseph also my wearing cloaths and two lots in the town of

Worwick to him & his heirs forever Item, it is my
 desire. that my wife Nelly Threlkeld do pay either
 in money or property the sum of 50 pounds to Mary
 Buckley Threlkeld and Rachel Threlkeld daughter
 of my brother Henry Threlkeld for the depreciation
 of the paper money as my being guardian to them
 and if they are satisfied with that sum then it is
 to be paid to them in twelve months after my decease
 if not satisfied then it is not to be paid then and
 that if it being paid then they are to give receipts. Lastly
 I appoint Nelly Threlkeld and my brother John Threlkeld
 & John Waggoner Executors to my th last will and testament
 In witness I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 31st

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day of January, 1790
