to pay them. It is my will and desire that my son John
shall be put to the House Carpenter and ~~Joiner~~ trade &
it is my Will also that the fifty Acres of Land Lying adjoin-
ing Daniel Ketchams and Alexander Almon and Allex-
ander Montgomery shall be sold and the price of it ^{to} put
to Interest for the use and benefit of the said John when
he comes of age or years of Maturity but Should the said
Decease this life before he comes of Age or years of Maturity
all the benefit arising from the Land shall belong to his
Mother. and also all the balance of my Movable Estate
shall be my wife's property to dispose of as she shall see
cause Lastly I appoint constitute and Ordain Daniel
Ketcham and Sim Boling my Executors hereby Reversing
all Other Wills. and declaring this to be my Last and
true Testament Sealed with my Seal and dated this
thirtieth day of May one thousand seven hundred &
