 Item I Give and bequeath to both my Son in Law John Carr and Samuel Ryker Ann Tullinwider and my son Peter Tullinwider two Children, Henry and Elizabeth Tullinwider to be Equally divided amongst them all that may be Recovered on two bonds on Isaac Morris one for fifty pounds the other for fifty Nine pound except the Nine pound which is to be paid to the person who goes for the money to them and their heirs forever
 Item I give unto my Son Jacob Tullinwider all the Balland of my Estate of whatsoever kind it may be. That is all my House hold and plantation Utensals together with all my Stock of every kind to him & his heirs forever
 Lastly I appoint my son Jacob Tullinwider and my son in Law John Carr. Executors to this my Last Will and Testament In Witness Whereof I have set my hand and seal the Sixteenth day of March 1793
