 sick & weak of body but of sound mind and
 disposing memory (for which I thank God) and
 calling to mind, the uncertainty of human life
 and being desirous of disposing of all such worldly
 estate as it hath pleased God to bless me
 with & give & bequeath the same in manner following
 that to wit: 1st I desire that all the perishable
 part of my estate be immediately sold after
 my decease and out of the income arising there-
 from all my just debts & funeral expenses be paid
 should the perishable part of my property prove
 insufficient for the above purpose then I desire that my
 executor hereafter named to sell my negro man
 Papantine (unless otherwise provided for) and out of
 the money arising therefrom pay & satisfy such of
 my just debts as shall remain unpaid out of the
 sale of my perishable part of my property -
 2^d after the payment of my debts & funeral expenses
 I give & bequeath to Agatha Chase Robinson one hundred
 acres of land that I own or on which shall be laid
 off by her to Charles Miles by running a line
 through my field parallel to the line that divides
 my land from S. D. Miles during her natural life
 after to descend to my son Richard Paxton Robinson
 I also give my wife A. R. Robinson my negro woman
 Amya & her children viz. John Melvot & William A.
 I give all money that are due or shall hereafter be due
 to dispose of as she pleases I desire that she shall not
 have control of the debt due me from David S. New-
 mired before collected - I also give her all property
 that may hereafter descend to me through her also all
 house hold & kitchen furniture that she brought
 on the premises - 3^d I give to my son Cyrus
 Deatun Robinson all of the balance of my fam-

on which, I reside - I also give him my negro man
Dick - Sarah - his wife & her children viz. Louisa, Emily
George, John, Jane, Francis Priscilla and O. Druggillson
also my negro woman & child Andrew I also give him
all of my books & ^{the} I give to my son Richard Patton
Robinson my interest in a tract of land in Hickman
County State of Kentucky it being the upper half of a tract
in which Smith O. Robinson now resides I also
give him my negro boy Davis & all of the negro
property that may here after descend to me through
my children except Dick -

I also give to my wife one horse & cow And
I fully & lawfully constitute and appoint Genl. C.
Smith, Moses Patton, Jas. J. Lehn, Smyth C. Rob-
inson and Wm. D. Helm - executors of this my last
will and Testament hereby revoking all other
^{former} wills and Testaments by me heretofore made In
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and affixed my seal, this day of December
in the year of our thousand eight hundred &
forty six
