

1 In the name of God amen I Thomas Armer of Warren County & State of Kentucky do make and declare this my last Will and Testament as follows to wit first I leave unto Byrd Lanier negroes all my wearing apparel, with the old Blanket and Rug. I give to Mr. Lanier my Green Spectacles. I give the remainder of my property to my wife Polly consisting of one Table one Bedstead and clothing, one bed two chairs, one Bucket. I leave to my step daughter Jane one checked Counterpane and one heifer to be kept by Daniel Stahl for her account till she shall be 15 years of age the heifer to be sold when she has a calf July 23rd 1813

In the name of God amen. I Aaron Earnest of the County of Warren and State of Kentucky being very weak in body but of a sound mind and understanding do constitute this my last Will and Testament and designe all whom it may concern to receive it as such, first of all I resign my Soul unto the hands of God who gave it and my body to the grave to be buried in a Christian manner. and as for my worldly goods with which I have been blessed I declare that after my decease that they be disposed of in the following manner (to wit) After the discharge of all lawfull debts and paying my funeral charges first of all that my son William Earnest have full possession of the plantation whereon I now live with all its appurtenances to have and to hold the same until my youngest daughter Polly Earnest comes to the age of ten years. In consideration of which the said William is to take good care of all my children as follows to wit, Jacob, Martin, John, Sally, Aaron, Henrietta and Polly he said William is to send the boys to school till they learn to read a write sufficient to do common business, and my daughters until they can read. I also wish for my household and Kitchen Furniture to be kept for the use of my children.
