First, I do allow all my lawfull Debts to be paid and do give and bequeath unto my beloved Aunt Elizabeth Raglin all my Estate goods and chattels only I do give and bequeath unto my Beloved Uncle David Rowland five Shillings Sterling money and to my beloved uncle George Rowland five Shilling Sterling money and to my beloved Aunt

Sarah Raglin five Shillings Sterling money & I do Disannul all Wills and Testaments heretofore made and this to be my last will and Testament or Testimony whereunto I have set my hand and Seal this Twentieth day of April Anno Domini

Will I Dazier Cavender of Woodford County and State of Kentucky being sick and weak in body but of perfect mind and memory, Thanks be to god, therefore Calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last

Will and Testament that is to say principally
and first of all I give and commend my soul
into the hand of Almighty God that gave it
and my body I commend to the Earth to be
Buried at their discretion my Executors
nothing Doubting but at the General Re-
-surrection I shall receive the same again by
the mighty power of God and as Touching
Such Worldly Estate as it hath pleased God
to give me in this life I give devise and
dispose and dispose of the same in the following
manner, And first Imp. imus I give and bequeath to
my loving wife Betsey Cavender, all and every part
of my estate during her Widowhood, and if she
Should Marry that the Childs part may be se-
-cured for him I do appoint my Betsey Cavender
my Executrix and Rowleigh Stott & Spencer
Gill my Executors of this my Will and Testament

Will

In the name of God Amen. I Harrison Harris being
forn armed by the infirmities of old age, of the approaching
dissolution of my body do make this my Last Will and
Testament, In the first place I commend my soul into
the hands of God who gave it and my body to the dust
in hopes of its Resurrection and reunion with my soul
to inherit eternal life through the Merits and mediation
of our Lord Jesus Christ the only and all Sufficient Sa-
-vour of sinful mankind, And as to the portions with
which it hath pleased God to Bless me in this world
I Dispose of them in the following manner Viz

I Will that the Tract of Land on which I now
reside containing 1500 Acres may be divided into three
parts as followeth, that 500 acres be laid off at the
eastward end thereof by a line running parallel
to the said Eastwardly end, and by another line
running parallel to the said Eastwardly end, that
600 acres be laid off at the Westwardly end leaving
500 acres in the Middle Division, I further Will
that the 100 acres thus laid off at the Eastwardly
end of my said 1500 acre Tract be again divided
