Ordered that William Stute, William Newton, Benjamin Berry & Isaac Johnson or any three of them being first sworn do attest, set apart & assign to Hannah Elder two thirds of John Elders Acre to her Right of dower in the Estate wherof the Dower said John Elders died possessed and make return thereof to the next Court.

We agreeable to the within Order proceeded to lay off the within Right of Dower and have laid off the same including the place called the Puncheon Camp it being the one third part of that tract lying within the lines of James Pumphrey containing 125 Acres and bounded as follows. To wit: Beginning at an Elm and two Hickory Saplings on Fields line and corner to John Sacks part of S. S. Land, thence South fifty five West 125 poles to three Sycs growing from one Root thence North thirty eight Degrees West and thence South fifty poles to a Sugar tree thence North fifty five East 125 poles to an ash and Sugar tree thence South thirty eight East 160 poles to the Beginning.
