Should Marry that the Childs part may be se-
-cured for him I do appoint my Butsey Cavender
my Executrix and Rowleigh Stott & Spencer
Gill my Executors of this my Will and Testament

Will

In the name of God Amen. I Harrison Harris being
forn armed by the infirmities of old age, of the approaching
dissolution of my body do make this my Last Will and
Testament, In the first place I commend my soul into
the hands of God who gave it and my body to the dust
in hopes of its Resurrection and reunion with my soul
to inherit eternal life through the Merits and mediation
of our Lord Jesus Christ the only and all Sufficient Sa-
-vour of sinful mankind, And as to the portions with
which it hath pleased God to Bless me in this world
I Dispose of them in the following manner Viz

I Will that the Tract of Land on which I now
reside containing 1500 Acres may be divided into three
parts as followeth, that 500 acres be laid off at the
easterly end thereof by a line running parallel
to the said Easterly end, and by another line
running parallel to the said Easterly end, that
600 acres be laid off at the Westward end leaving
500 acres in the Middle Division, I further Will
that the 100 acres thus laid off at the Easterly
end of my said 1500 acre Tract be again divided

into two equal parts by a line running at right angles to the said Eastwardly end, And I will & bequeath unto my Daughter Susanna Harris and to her heirs forever, either half of the said 400 acres of Land which she or her Legal Representatives shall choose, and I also will and bequeath to her my Negro Girl named Agge and to her heirs forever, And I give and bequeath unto my son Randolph Harris, and to his heirs forever the remaining half of the said 400 acres of Land, And I further will that the 600 acres to be laid off the Westwardly end of my said 1500 acres as above directed may be again divided into two parts by a line running at right angles to the said Eastwardly end, so that 200 acres may be Northwardly and 400 acres Southwardly of the said last directed dividing line, And I give and bequeath unto my son Nathaniel Harris, and to his heirs forever the last mentioned 200 acres of Land lying in the Northwestwardly corner of my said 1500 acre Tract, And I give and bequeath unto my son-in-law William Hicks and to my Daughter his wife Elizabeth Hicks and to their heirs forever the last mentioned 400 acres of Land lying in the Southwardly corner of my said 1500 Acre Tract, for the one

half of the said 400 acres the said William Hicks has paid me the full Value, and therefore he and his heirs are to hold it in their own right, the other half is to be held by the said Elizabeth Hicks and her heirs. And I further will that the Middle division of my said 1500 acres containing 500 acres may be divided into two parts in the manner which has been agreed on between my son in law William Adams and me and so as that 300 acres shall be contained in the Northwardly division including the Plantation on which I live, and the Spring I commonly use, and so as that 200 acres shall be contained in the Southwardly Division including the said William Adams' Plantation and Spring; I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mourning Adams wife of the said William Adams and to her heirs forever, the two hundred acres of Land last mentioned it being the Southwardly part of the said Middle Division of my said 1500 acre Tract, and I give and bequeath to my son David Harris, and to his heirs forever, the three hundred acres of Land last mentioned it being the Northwardly part of the said Middle

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Division of my said 1500 acre Tract, reserving
giving and bequeathing to my beloved wife
Martha Harris, during her natural life the
use possession and profits of the said three hun-
-dred acres of Land and its appurtenances,
I also give and bequeath unto my said wife
during her natural life my Negroes Beck, Ned,
Bob, Dick, Salt, Rose, Jude, Daniel, Joe, and
Jenny, as also all my live Stock, and goods, &
Chattles, of every kind, And it is hereby declared
to be my meaning and intent that the Land
Negroes and all the rest of my Estate herein
devised to my said Wife Martha are in Trust
for the comfortable support of herself and my
unmarried Children so long as they continue
Single and choose to reside with her, and for
the payment of such Legal Demands as may
from time to time arise or be brought against
my estate in her possession, but she is not to
be accountable for the disposal of the profits
of my said Estate nor for the Disposal of any
of my goods and Chattles, I further Will that
at my said Wife's death, all the Negroes herein

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devised to her, and their future increase be
equally Divided between all my before named
Six Children to be for them and their heirs forever.
And I further Will that whatsoever shall remain
-main of my personal Estate at my said Wife's
decease, after her funeral expences and Legall
Debts are paid, shall be equally Divided be-
-tween my three Children. Randolph, Davice,
and Susanna, and their heirs, and I further
declare that what I have herein devised to my
said wife is in lieu of her legal Dower of my
Estate and is to be accepted by her as such, and
that what I have devised to my Children respec-
-tively is in lieu and full compensation of
all claims and Demands, that they shall set
up to any other or further part of my estate
and if any of them or their Legal representa-
-tives shall bring suit for more, I hereby Will
and ordain that his her or their heirs who
shall thus do shall for themselves and theirs forfeit
what is herein given and devised to them;
And I further Will and Ordain, that all

my estate which shall so become forfeited shall be
equally Divided between the rest of my Children
and their heirs who shall remain peaceable, Finally,
I hereby nominate constitute and Appoint my
sons Randolph Harris and David Harris, to be
Executors of this my Last Will and Testament
herely revoking and disannulling all former Wills
by me made, In witness whereof I have
herunto set my hand this day of September
One thousand seven hundred and ninety

codicil to this my last Will and Testament, viz

Whereas I have Willed and directed in this my
Last Will and Testament, that whatsoever is left
of my personal Estate at the decease of my Wife
+ shall be equally Divided between my three Children
Randolph David and Susanna and whereas

I have since divided and given of to my said
Daughter Susanna, what I think a reasonable
part of my personal ~~estate~~, I now will and
Divise that at my said Wife decease, that all
my live stock, and all my other goods and
Chattels of every kind shall be equally divided
between my said sons Randolph and David and
their heirs, And I now also make this further
alteration in my said Will, viz, that after my
Wife decease when my Negroes therein named
and their increase are divided into five equal
Divisions, my will is that my son David shall
Choose such one of the said Divisions as he shall
think proper, to be for him and his heirs forever
and I will and divise that the remaining four
divisions of my said Negroes shall be divided by
lot, between my four Children, Randolph
Nathaniel, Elizabeth and Mourning to be
for them and their heirs forever, In witness

day of April one thousand seven hundred &
ninety one
