I Peter January of Fayette County in the State of Virginia being aged and
of sound mind and memory do make this my Last Will and
Testament as followeth. Viz. I commend my soul into the
hands of God, trusting for salvation through the merits of
Christ Jesus my savior and I will that my at my death
body be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my
Executors. And as to the Estate with which I am possessed
in this world. I give and Bequeath to my Sons Samuel
January and John January the Tract of Land on which
I now live and for which I have my Son in Law William
McMinn's Obligation and by which I expect a title will be
obtained for three hundred Acres be the same more or less to
them and their Heirs and Assigns forever to be equally divided
between my said two Sons in a convenient manner according to
Quantity and Quality, but if either of my said two Sons or
should die before they marry or come to the Age of twenty one
years, then I will that the whole of the said Land should
go the surviving One and to his Heirs and Assigns forever.
I Also give to my said two Sons all my Plantation Utensils
all my household and Kitchen furniture except One Bed and
its furniture which I shall give to my Wife.
I Give and Bequeath to my Wife Deborah January One
of my Beds and the Furniture which she shall choose and
her choice of one of my mares two of my Cows and two
of my Sheep. - I Also Give to my said Wife that African
Briggs an Infant Girl who is bound to me by my Last Will
until she attain the age of Eighteen years.

Will that my said Wife be decently supported during
Life, by my two Sons above named for and in consideration
of the Land that I have herein devised to them.
I Give and Bequeath my books to be equally divided between
my Sons James and Ephraim January and John and my
daughters Sarah. And I further give and bequeath all the
remainder of my Estate to my Sons James and Ephraim and my
daughters Sarah to be equally divided between them and their Heirs.
But if my daughter Nancy should remove into the district
of Kentucky it is my Will that she should have a good Cow
and Calf out of my Estate. And I hereby constitute and
appoint my said Sons James and Ephraim January Executors
of this my Last Will and Testament hereby revoking and
disannulling all former Wills by me made declaring and
publishing this to be my only true Last Will and Testament
this 26th day of February 1787.
