at the age of eighteen or have no heir, then that
part to Descend to son William & should he die his
part to Descend if the Other be alive to it if not
the whole to Descend to John Parker. Second-

Daughter, my William at the age of eighteen to
have his choice of one Tract of Land, the rest to
be equally Divided, my Wife to have the liberty to
sell any of my Land that she may think proper
for the maintenance & education of my Children
I do like wise appoint her Richard Steuts and
John Parker Executors of this my last Will & Testament
