being first sworn do allot and set apart and assign
to Agnes Cox her Right of Dower in the Estate
whereof Samuel Cox did possess and make report
thereof to the next Court

Agnes Cox's In Obedience to an Order of Court to us directed we have
met on the Land of Samuel Cox Esq^r and by consent of
Dower the parties have procured to allot & set apart & assign to
Agnes Cox her Right of Dower in manner and form
following Beginning at Samuel Moxley's corner on the
Road near the three mile Tree to Frankfort, thence

his line to his corner, thence with Sam^l Cox's line to Meigs
Elkhorn, thence up the same to Bennet Pemberton's corner on
the Creek, thence his line to the Road to the leading from
George Town to Frankfort thence along said Road to a
Walnut on the North side of said Road within about fifteen
Poles of the Springs, thence crossing the Road running a-
bout twenty Poles to a Stake from thence running parallel and
so as to include the Peach Orchard thence with the Orchard to the
Road thence with the Road to the Beginning. But be it remem-
bered that the said Agnes Cox is to keep the way the way open
to the Spring for the use of the parties holding the above Lots
Also the said Agnes Cox is not to interrupt Henry Bartlett
in the lease said Bartlett has for two years to come.
