In the name of God Amos Thomas Johnson of Woodford County district of Kentucky being weak in body but of sound memory Blesed be god do this day - August 1792 Twenty fourth in the year of Louis the sixteenth One thousand seven hundred and Ninety two make & publish this my last Will and Testament in the manner following, that is to say, First I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Elizabeth one third of my personal Estate also she is to superintend and manage all my personal Estate and Clear Land till my eldest son become of age; Secondly, I give and bequeath unto my eldest son David Three hundred Acres of land of the place I now live on, to be taken at his pleasure of either line he chooses when he come of age, Also I give and bequeath unto my son Silas Two hundred and Fifty Acres at his own choice which ever of David's line he sees cause to begin at so that his own line may still David's side less that the lines may be equal and no Vacant Land Between Also I give and bequeath unto my four Daughters Mary, Anna, Betsey & Sally the residue of my Land four hundred Acres to be equally divided among them four, All my personal estate horses Cows, Sheep &c. are to be at my Wife disposal until the children are of age or shall be so with all her situation and for the present she shall have privilege with my other Executors to appoint out as my present stock as will be sufficient to Build a house for her and the children

to live in and in case any of my heirs should die their part shall be divided amongst the surviving ones as it stands here stated, Furthermore I give unto my son David a bay Colt named Prince as his own property over and above his common share, Also Burket's Explanation on the New Testament, I make and bequeath my wife my Sole Executrix of this my will in trust for the debts and purposes in this my will contained and I make my loving friend Joseph Hughes & Thomas Reed both of Fayette County Executors & Overseers for this my last will to take care and see the same performed according to my true intent and meaning In Witness whereof I the said Thomas Johnson have to this my last will and Testament set my hand and seal in the day & year above written
