named Molly during her natural life and  
at her death the said Molly and her

all her Children I Give and bequeath to my  
beloved daughter Molly Hawks one negro  
Woman named Betty and also one girl  
named Jane and one bed and furniture  
during her natural life and at her death  
to be equally divided among all her Children  
I Give to my beloved Daughter Wiley grassy  
one negro boy named Bill during her natural  
life and at her death to be equally divided  
among all her Children I Give to my  
beloved son Nathan Dale whom I appoint will  
William Tillery to be my Executor of this  
will one negro man named George to him  
and his heirs forever I Give to my beloved  
Daughter Nancy Brent my riding Horse and  
Saddle and one bed and furniture and women  
of my wearing clothes during her natural life  
and at her death to be equally divided among all  
all the Children she had by her first Husband  
It is my desire that the remaining part of  
my clothes be divided <sup>between</sup> among all the rest of my  
daughters then living it is my desire that my  
negro boy Sam shall be sold and the money  
given to my son Rowland Dale  
I Give to my beloved daughter Lucy Rowland  
two Children Harry and Nancy Rowland

part of my estate may be equally divided  
among all my children then living
