of Kentucky contemplating the uncertainty of life and
Mortality of my body do make and ordain this my
last Will & Testament

1. I want that my Just Debts be paid out of my personal Estate & hereafter, my funeral to be conducted as my Executor hereafter named shall direct.
2. I give and bequeath to my wife Hannah all the benefits of my Real Estate and landed claims with all profits thereof, my Household utensils and Farming Tools, for the support of herself the Education and support and cloathing of my children during her Widowhood.
3. At the Expiration of her Widowhood by death or other wise my Estate in Lands is to be divided as the Existing laws directs only with this Exception that each of my sons is to have two shares, so that they Respectively may have twice as much as each of my Daughters.
4. My personal Estate is to be then divided as the Laws directs. Each of my Children having an equal part.
5. My Children are to support their respective proportions as they severally arrive at the Age of Twenty one years, or at their Marriages if my Executors Judge

It prudent and best, Although the state of my wife's
weakness may not have expired

I do appoint my beloved wife Hannah my friends
John Parker and Levi Todd to be the Executors of this
my last will & Testament
