Lee W^m Elizabeth Lee agreeing that he should be paid out of her third part of the negro her third part of the personal property was attested as follows vizt. Two old oxen and old white fawn bow a small brown Cow a small bull a small brown Heifer a brindle steer and a black heifer with a white back an old black mare with a young colt a young grey horse a small bay horse and two grey mares, a small colt, & a light grey colt - and three shap - Records to John Lee his eighth part of the remainder of slaves and personal estate as follows vizt. of the negroes Jude, Bob, George (son of George & Kate). Jesse and Jingo - of the personal estate a bay mare and a grey colt, a dark red bow with a star and a young spotted bow and three shap, and to make up small deficiencies in the allotment his proportion of the slaves and personal estate there is further allotted to him a read sparring Heifer and a small brown sparring steer.
