 with the one share received the most of my

of September in the year of our Lord One
thousand seven hundred and ninety nine

of land part of the estate of the said decedent agree-
ably to the annexed plat, and have allotted that

to the said Robert Dale and that part which
is inscribed N.º 2. to the said Peggy Johnson, the
Witn^{rs} of our hands and Seals this day of September
1799.
