sister Susanna Thompson my negro woman named Kate &
all her future increase to her and the Heirs of her Body
for ever, - 2^d I give and bequeath to my Brother Henry
Thompson my Negro Girl named Sarah and her future

124) increase to him and his lawful heirs for ever, I desire that my Negro Girl named Betty, may be sold by my Executors hereafter named, and out of the monies arising from such sale all my last debts and funeral expenses be paid. Should the amount of the price of said Negro be insufficient for the above mentioned purposes I desire that the balance may be made up of my other Estate not herein before particularly disposed of, and then all the rest of my Estate both real & personal, I give & bequeath to my said sister Susanna Thomson and Henry Thomson, and to their heirs forever, to be between them by giving my said sister my gray roan mare and Twenty pounds Cash Extraordinary; and then the balance to be Equally divided between my said sister and Brother,

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my Friends William Todd and John Blanton Jr., Executors and my sister Susanna Thomson Executive of this my last will & Testament, hereby revoking all other former Wills or Testaments by me heretofore made.
