tiff of the County of Woodford and State of
Kentucky being sick yet of perfect mind
and memory And calling to mind the mortality
of my body, and knowing that it is appointed
unto all men once to die, Do make & ordain
this my last Will and Testament: and as

touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath
pleased God to bless me with in this life I give and
dispose of the same in the following manner & form
Viz. First. I give and bequeath unto my son
Samuel fifty pounds in cash as soon as it can
be collected.

Also. To my Daughter Elizabeth, one Negro Girl named
Kate one Bed and furniture

Also. To my Daughter Mary, one Negro boy named David
one Bed and furniture

Also. To my Daughter Betsey, one Negro boy named Lewis

Also. To my Sons William, Thomas, Joseph Josiah Alexan-
der and Elisha one Horse and Saddle worth fifteen
pounds, apiece as they come to be of age.

Also. To my well beloved wife Mary one horse named
and saddle, one bed and furniture at her
own disposal, and the balance of my estate
after all my just debts, is paid, during her
life time or widowhood to raise the children
upon, and for the maintenance of my sister
Mary, as long as she lives upon the plantation,
except Rachel has any more children,
and if she has, one to be given to my daugh-
ter Susannah if not I bequeath her forty pounds
when she comes of age or at the last Division of my
Estate to be at the Death or Marriage of my wife Divi-
ed equally amongst my sons William, Thomas, Joseph
Josiah, Alexander, and Elisha before named, And if my
Wife Mary and my Executors think proper that
they sell this Tract of Land and buy out Lands to

the advantage of the above named six sons
 And I do hereby appoint my trusty friend Alex-
 -der McFlure and my son Samuel Rattliff ex-
 -tors of this my last Will and Testament And
 I do hereby utterly disavow revoke & annul
 all and every other former Wills and Testaments
 Legacies and bequests by me in any wise Will
 & bequests Ratifying and Confirming this my
 last will and Testament In Witness whereof I
 have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 18th of
 August in the year of our Lord 1796

 - house, on Tuesday the third day of January, one
 thousand seven hundred, and ninety seven, This
 last Will and testament of Thomas Rattliff
 deceased, was presented in Court and proved
 by the oaths of Samuel McFlure Robert Elliott
 & William Mof the Witnesses thereto, and order
 - ed to be recorded, & on the motion of Alexander
 McFlure and Samuel Rattliff the Executors
 therein named, who made oath as the law directs,
 and together with Robert Elliott and Samuel
 McFlure their Securities entered into and acknow-
 - ledged bond in the penalty of Two thousand
 pounds conditioned according to law; certificate is
