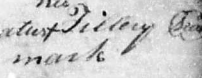

In first place I recommend my soul in the blessings of all mighty God that first gave it and for my body to be buried in a Christian like manner and for such worldly goods that it hath pleased God to bless me with I give and desire as followeth I give I give all my estate real and personal to Winney Scourlock Wife of Thomas Scourlock my will and desire is that Sally George mi Darnit shall have year schooling out of the said Estate and appoint my friend Jar Howard my sole and Sole Executor of this my Last will and testament in Witness whereof I have fixt my hand and seal this twenty ninth day of April and In the year one thousand Eight hundred and Eight and in presnts of
