Executrix Hereof Desiring that so long as
she shall be a widow she shall not be
bound to give bond and security in the
premises

2. It shall be at her Discretion to settle
Disputes Existing or which may Exist in my
estate real or personal by suit arbitration
or Compromise -

17 3. any Debt Bonds receipts or other things
which may be necessary in the adjustment
of the affairs of my estate whether real
or personal she shall have full power
to Execute and Deliver or receive as
the case may be

4. In case it shall be necessary to sell my
estate real and personal or any part
thereof to pay my Debt she may do it and
make the necessary Conveyances.

5. I appoint her Guardian of my children
however to each of them the right of
Choosing another when of legal age so
to do.

6. I do hereby revoke all former wills
and declare this one only to be in force
