

In the name of god Amen I Robert Mitchell of the County of Woodford & state of Kentucky being weak of Body but of sound mind and memory do make constitute and appoint this my last will and testament and after recommending my soul to the Lord who gave it and my body to be decently interred by my executors whom I shall hereafter appoint. I dispose of my worldly affairs in the following manner (viz) I will and allow all my just debts to be paid out of personal or moveable estate and then I bequeath to my beloved Wife Elizabeth her mare the sorrel mare and her saddle with her bed and bed cloths and the third part of the moveable Estate all to be hers and to be at her whole sole disposal and her maintenance in the present dwelling house on the plantation while she continues unmarried. I Likewise bequeath to my eldest son John six shillings. Also I Bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Reed six shillings. I Likewise Bequeath to my three sons Robert Samuel & Thomas Mitchels six hundred acres of land laying on drowning creek in Madison County to be divided equally among them in Quantity and quality to be theirs their heirs &c forever Also I Bequeath to my daughter Sarah Mitchel six shillings Likewise I Bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Mitchel six shillings Likewise I Bequeath the plantation whereon I now live to my two sons William & Alexander Mitchel it being three hundred and nine acres to equally divided between them in Quantity & Quality to be theirs their heirs &c forever and William is to have the present dwelling house with that dividend of land falling to him and to keep his mother dwigh her widowhood Also I Bequeath to my daughter Margaret a good horse saddle &

bridle with a bed and bed cloaths. Also I allow Robert Samuel & Thomas to pay Margaret five pounds each one of them. also I allow William & Alexander to pay her eight pence as each one of them and the residue of the property that is not willed away with all debts contracts and Bargains due to me or any part or parcel of my estate Real or personal that is not herein mentioned I Bequeath and leave to be divided at the discretion of the Executors amongst the whole of the Legates excepting Rebecca Reed. and I hereby nominate constitute ordain and appoint my two sons Robert & William Mitchels to be the sole executors of this my last will and testament and Lastly I hereby Disannul Revoke and renounce all other wills by me heretofore made ordaining and confirming this to be my last will and Testament and no other. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this tenth day of September one thousand Eight Hundred and three
