Pursuant to an Order of the Worthy
Court of Woodford County, we the under
signed Commissioners being duly sworn
according to law - proceeded to allot to the
widow of John Samuel deceased her
share on able dower in the slaves of
which the said John Samuel died
possessed and which were produced to us
(viz) a Negro Man named Lachary valued
at £120 a Negro woman named Melly
valued at £100 a Negro lad named Ambrose
valued at £90. This allotment was
made by the Commissioners with the
assent and approbation of those representa-
tives who were of full age and of
the Guardians of those who were minors.
Given under our hands and seals this
6th day of April 1807
