In the name of God Amen I Abraham Gregory of Wardford County do make Ordain and Publish this my last Will and Testament after paying all my just debts I leave & dispose of my estate both real and personal to my Wife Mildred Gregory during her natural life I then 1st I bequeath and bequeath one half of my Slaves and one half of my personal estate to my Wife Mildred Gregory to dispose of by her last Will and Testament (or as she shall make either in my life time or after my Death and should she make no other Will I do hereby ratify and confirm the Will she has already made concerning the premises. Item 2nd It is my will that at my wife's Death the other half of my Slaves be emancipated and set free such as are under the age of twenty one years to be subject to the disposition of my wife until they arrive at that age. Item 3rd It is my will that two tracts of land be made equal in Value by metes and having regard to quality as well as quantity

278 and at the Death of my wife I devise
the tract of land lately Bought of Joseph
William with all its appertinances to
John Gregory William Gregory and William
Moore Gregory and at the Death of said
John & William Gregory I devise the same
to William Moore Gregory and his heirs forever
nevertheless it is my Will that the negroes
that I have herin set free shall have
the use of so much of said land as my
Execs May Judge necessary for them as long
as they Chose to live on it and they are
to pay said John William & William

Item 4th The tract of land whereon I
now live with its appertinances I devise
to my wife Mildred Gregory to dispose
off by her last Will and Testament made
either in my life time or after my Death and
in Case she makes no Other Will it is to
be Subject to said portion which she has already
made by Will Executed reserving two acres
of the same on which the Meeting House
at Big Spring stands for the special use
of the Baptist Church at that place —

Item 5th From the remaining half of my
estate not Subjecting either my lands or negroes
to the payment I devise the following Legacies to
be paid after my wifes death (Exonit)

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- 1st To Peter Williams Nickman one Horse worth
one Hundred dollars.
2nd To John Gregory and Joseph Guy my Strs with
3rd To Abraham Smith one Arkansas Ram in Cash
4th To Gregory Nancy one Arkansas Ram in Cash
5th To Abraham Watts one Arkansas Ram in Cash
6th To Abraham Sparks two Hundred Dollars in Cash

And I do so publicly declare it to be my Will that
in Case any Legatee of Legacies mentioned in this Fifth
Item departs this life before the death of my Wife and
myself the Legacy as so such shall be void and
passes into my Estate —

Item 6th I give two Hundred Dollars to be laid out
on the Meeting House at Big Spring. Item
7th The negroes herin set free have to finish the Crop
growing at my Death and at my wifes Death
before they have their liberty. Item 8th at my
Death I give Silas M. Noel twenty Dollars
first Charge in my Flock of Sheep. Item 9th
at my wifes death I desire that this half my
personal Estate to remain for the use of William
Gregory during his natural life and at his death
I give the same to John Gregory lastly I
appoint my wife Mildred Gregory Executrix and
Silas M. Noel George Stoll Gray and Walter
Ayers Executors of this my last Will and Testament
hereby appointing all attorn by me herinfore made
or published in Witness whereof I have hereunto

This the last Will and Testament of Abraham Gregory was produced and read and perused by the Court of Robert Viny and William Bailey two subscribing witnesses thence and entered its record. Whereupon Silas M. Neal Matter Esq. & George A. Olney the executors therein named came into Court and took the oath required by law and executed bond with Charles Buck Lewis Sullivan & James Sullivan their securities in the penalty of \$20,000 Conditioned according to law
