of my household Furniture be sold and the
proceeds, equally divided amongst all
my Daughters. I do hereby give to
my Executors full power and authority
Jointly or Separately to make Deeds of
Conveyance for any lands or Lotts I may here
hold and not yet conveyed. I do hereby nominate
Constitute and appoint my son Samuel
Campbell and William Steele Executors
of this my last Will & Testament. In
Testimony Whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and affixed my seal this seventh

day of February 1815

This the last Will and Testament of Legg
Campbell was pronounced in Court and approved
by the Oaths of William Steele John McGuire
& Robert Steele Subscribing themselves thereto and
ordains to record and Whereupon Samuel
Campbell one of the Executors therein named
came into Court and took the Oaths required
by law and Executed bond with David
Campbell and Abraham H. H. H. his securities
in the Penalty of \$5000 conditioned according
to law and leave reserved for the other executor
therein named to qualify.
