 possess all my Estate both personal and real
 as long as she remains a widow & if should marry
 again to be divided & after her death it is my
 desire that all the remaining part of my Estate
 may be Equally divided among All my children
 (to wit) Malindy Shelton Hiram, Eliager,
 Emily, Ansel and lastly I appoint my wife
 Nancey & Medley Shelton Executors of this
 my last will
