It is my will that the plantation whereon I now live be sold of the proceeds to be divided as follows (I wit), One equal third to be paid to my son Gilbert Campbell & One equal third to my son Samuel Campbell & One hundred Dollars of the remaining one third to be paid to my daughter Nancy Corkham & all the balance of the last mentioned one third to be equally divided between my said daughter Nancy

Winkham and all the rest of my
Daughters. I Give and bequeath to my
son Robert Campbell one bed and furniture
& One Crop of ~~the~~ ^{the} ~~land~~ ^{land}. I give and bequeath
to my son Samuel Campbell all my
farming utensils the Wagon and ~~the~~
I Give and bequeath to my five Daughters
the Frankfort Ferry with its appurtenances
to them and their heirs forever —

I give and bequeath to my five daughters
Phadessa Mary Elizabeth Janet & Henry
One hundred and Fifty Dollars of the money
arising from the sale of Lott in the town
of Schell Frankfort be equally divided
among them, It is my will that my
negro man Tom and my negro woman
Cidy the Cattle & sheep & the Ballance
of my household Furniture be sold and the
proceeds, equally divided amongst all
my Daughters. I do hereby give to
my Executors full power and authority

Conveyance for any lands or Lotts I may here
hold and not yet conveyed. I do hereby nominate
